Camp tuition is \$46.00 a day.



Please refer to the calendar, for drop off and pick up times. We cannot stress enough, the importance of being on time ,to pick up your child. We will not have use of the building ,or staff to accommodate your child, if they are not picked up on time. Also, please be mindful of drop off times. The bus cannot wait for children who are late. Pick up and Drop off is at the Mechanicville Elementary School. PLEASE HAVE YOUR CHILD ARRIVE NO LATER THAN 8:45 ON FIELD TRIP DAYS. We are getting groups together and it is very hard to do this efficiently and safely with children arriving late.

Each camper will be provided one t-shirt. Campers must wear their camp t-shirts on off site field trips. We will be providing a link to Val's Sporting Goods Store, if you wish to order more.



On July 12th,19th,and 26th. we will be going to Saratoga Strike Zone, Liberty Ridge and the Fun Spot. On these days the children are allowed to bring "Snack Bar Money". This will be used by them for snacks, games and arcade fun. Each campers money, will be carried by their counselor, for that day. The children are given their money, at the designated time, when we are at the destination . Their counselor will try their best to guide the children during their purchases.
